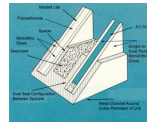
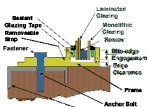

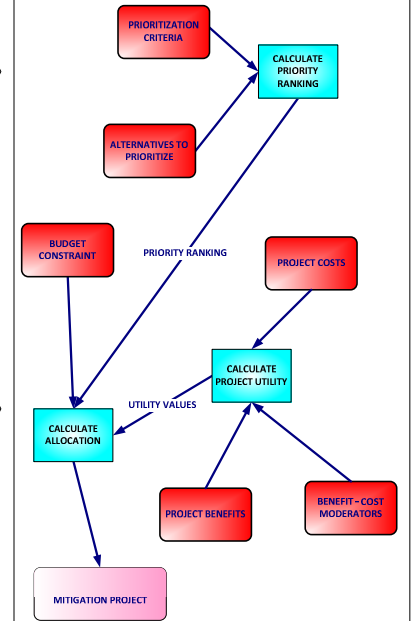


Problem

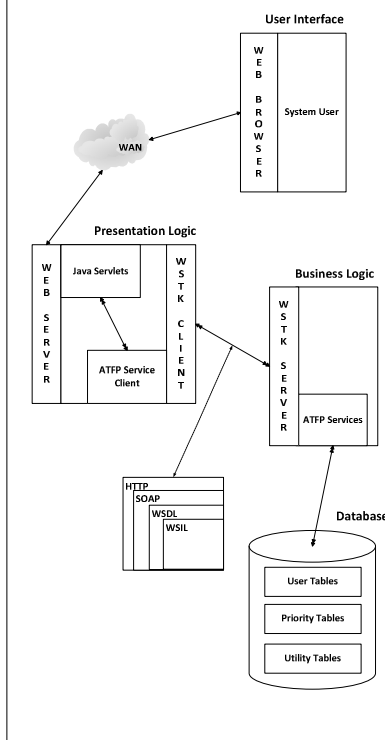
Allocate limited anti-terrorism resources to protect highest-priority infrastructure with most effective mitigations.

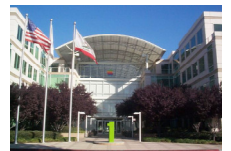
